In today's world of horse showing, a horse show is a judged exhibition of horses and ponies. Many different horse breeds and equestrian disciplines hold competitions from local to the International levels. At Brek-n-Ridge Farm we specialize on show preparedness, confidence, arena usage, accuracy, and teaching the useful tools geared for the riders unique style of riding. Each student at Brek-n-Ridge Farm will leave the stable with advanced skill and better judgement. Dressage is the French word for "TRAINING" and the instructors at Brek-n-Ridge Farm love to teach.

Show Fees are **\$100.00** per day per horse and covers the coaching of the rider and training of the horse at the show. Additional costs are Instructor (s) travel expenses, accommodations and a per diem of **\$30.00** per day per instructor. These expenses will be divided among the clients.

Show grooming is not included and is the responsibility of the rider. If grooming/handling is requested or deemed necessary the charge is **\$50.00** per day. The grooms per diem and accommodations will be divided among the clients.

Ready to Show preparation includes mane pulling, tail grooming and clipping **\$35.00**
Braiding **\$45.00**
Mane Pulling **\$25.00**
Hauling per loaded mile **\$2.00**

Our goal is to teach the fundamentals of taking care of horses and riding horses. We accomplish this through hands-on experience in a safe environment.
